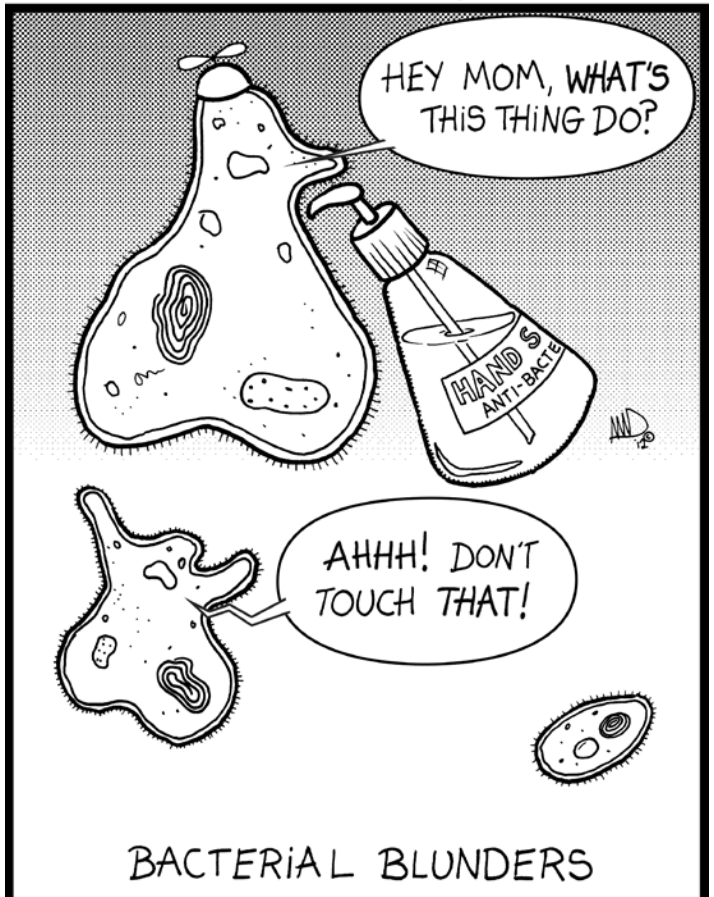


Great Women • Great Ideas • Great Things

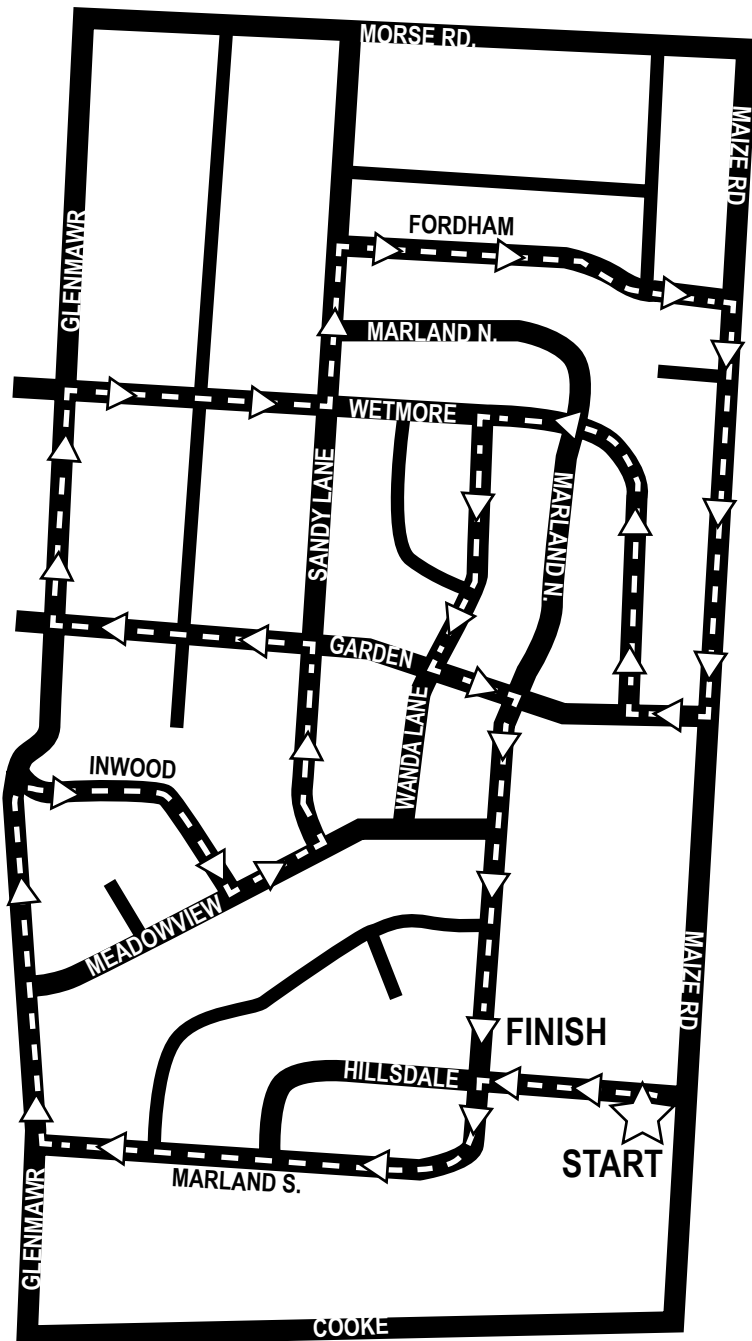

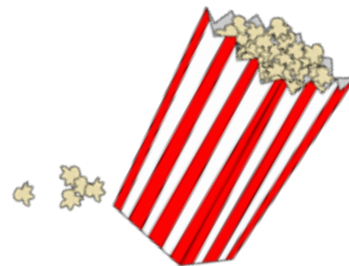
